Re: HERBs Report - Good

Every half-term teachers provide a score telling us what impression they have of the attitude to learning shown by the students they teach. The results of this latest monitoring can be found in your child's homework planner.

The monitoring looks at four different things:

- Homework – How well organised are students to complete homework, revision and independent study tasks to a suitable standard?
- Effort – How much commitment, application and resilience do they show in this subject?
- Readiness for Work – How motivated are the students at the start of lessons to engage with learning?
- Behaviour for Learning - Are the students behaving in such a way that learning is enhanced, satisfactory or disrupted?

I am pleased to inform you that your child has been working well and has been recognised as being good or outstanding in almost all aspects across all subjects studied. Please discuss with your child the area(s) where they were graded 3 or 4 and congratulate them on their excellent attitude towards learning in most subjects.

When the next HERBs Report is compiled, we hope your child will make it into the Honours category by scoring an average of 1.5 or better (with no 3's or 4's).
